PHD DISSERTATION TOPIC

THE DISSERTATION, TITLED "CRIMINAL PROTECTION OF FAMILY BONDS: A COMPARATIVE STUDY," AIMED TO HIGHLIGHT THE ROLE OF JORDANIAN LEGISLATORS IN PRESERVING THE COHESION OF FAMILY MEMBERS AND PRIORITIZING FAMILY INTERESTS OVER JUSTICE CONSIDERATIONS. THE STUDY EXAMINED HOW CRIMINAL POLICY VARIES IN TERMS OF CRIMINALIZATION AND PUNISHMENT. FOR INSTANCE, LEGISLATORS SOMETIMES IMPOSE HARSHER PENALTIES, EMPHASIZING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE OFFENDER AND THE VICTIM, AS IN CASES OF INCESTUOUS RAPE. IN OTHER INSTANCES, THEY REDUCE OR EXEMPT THE OFFENDER FROM PUNISHMENT BASED

ON THEIR ROLE WITHIN THE FAMILY, SUCH AS IN CASES OF THEFT BETWEEN SPOUSES.

THE MAIN ISSUE ADDRESSED IN THE STUDY WAS WHETHER THE JORDANIAN PENAL CODE ADEQUATELY COVERS CRIMES AFFECTING THE FAMILY AND HOW FAMILY INTERESTS CAN TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER THE STATE'S RIGHT TO PUNISH. THE DISSERTATION WAS DIVIDED INTO THREE CHAPTERS, FOCUSING ON CRIMES RELATED TO MARRIAGE CONTRACTS, SEXUAL OFFENSES WITHIN THE FAMILY, AND CRIMES AFFECTING FAMILY COHESION, SUCH AS DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND LINEAGE DISPUTES. THE STUDY CONCLUDED WITH SEVERAL FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS.
